Scholarship Background

The Cooper-Miller Organ Scholarship was established by the Board in 2008 and is presented in memory of two distinguished organists from Raleigh, North Carolina, to encourage promising young musicians and support them in the early stages of their organ education. One or more winners are chosen each year at the direction of the Scholarship Committee to receive financial assistance in their studies. Applicants are heard in person at a church in Raleigh, NC, each year. Since our Andersen Scholarship is primarily for older students, the Cooper-Miller Scholarship is meant to assist students in the earlier stages of their musical studies.

Application Process

- Letter of Recommendation from teacher(s), including both specific criteria on a set scale and descriptive comment
- Student's written statement of goals and intentions in organ study and service
- Statement from parents/guardian/responsible party that they will encourage/support student's interest in studying organ
